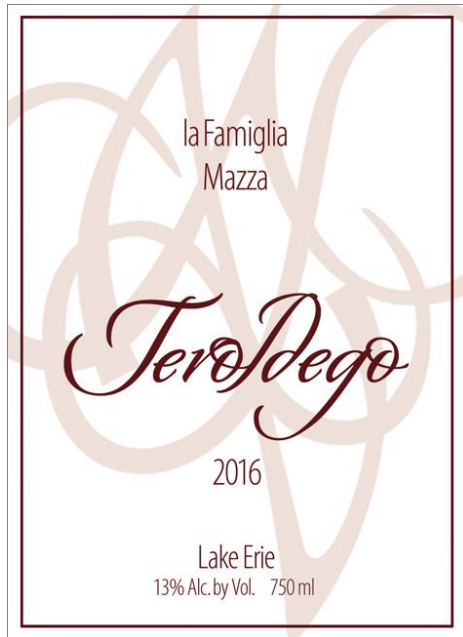


Teroldego
