

NEW YORK ≡ COMMON PASSION RADLER

Alcohol: 4%

IBUs: 14

SRM: 4.8 (Light Golden)

Grain Bill: NY Pale Malt, Malted Barley, Malted Wheat, Munich Malt and Vienna Malt

Hops: NY Perle added for bittering, NY Perle and NY Cascade in whirlpool for flavor/aroma.

Brewing Notes: Brewed to be light in color and in mouth feel. Fermented with ale yeast at low temperatures makes this beer clean and crisp. Bittermens all natural *Passionfruit Nectar Syrup* cocktail syrup added during ferment helps retain the delicate passionfruit flavor and aroma.

Tasting Notes: unCommon Passion is a clear golden ale, highly carbonated with a light, fizzy head. This beer has a strong aroma of berries and tropical fruit with a light malt backnote. The flavor starts with bright tropical fruit and finishes with a slight citrus bitterness and thirst quenching light mouthfeel.

This is our take on the traditional Radler (German for “cyclist”), a light and refreshing “beer cocktail.” Bike not included.
