Vintage: 2021

Appellation: Lake Erie

Residual Sugar: 0%

Alcohol: 12%

Varieties: Riesling (100%)

Winemaking/Ferment notes: Tesoro ("Treasure") is an old world Riesling. It is a high acidity dry Riesling which had been aged in a new puncheon for about 9 months – in the style of old world Rieslings. The wine has a potential to last at least 5-10 years in the bottle however the high acidity and new oak need time to settle down and integrate in the bottle. This is a wine that you should ideally forget in your cellar for at least a few years. If you do, the result is likely to be a wine that is very complex with notes of ripe apples, stone fruit, vanilla, caramel and a palate that's very fruity with hints of spice and minerals at the end. If you do want to drink it now, we suggest opening the bottle and let it breathe for about 20 minutes before pouring.
