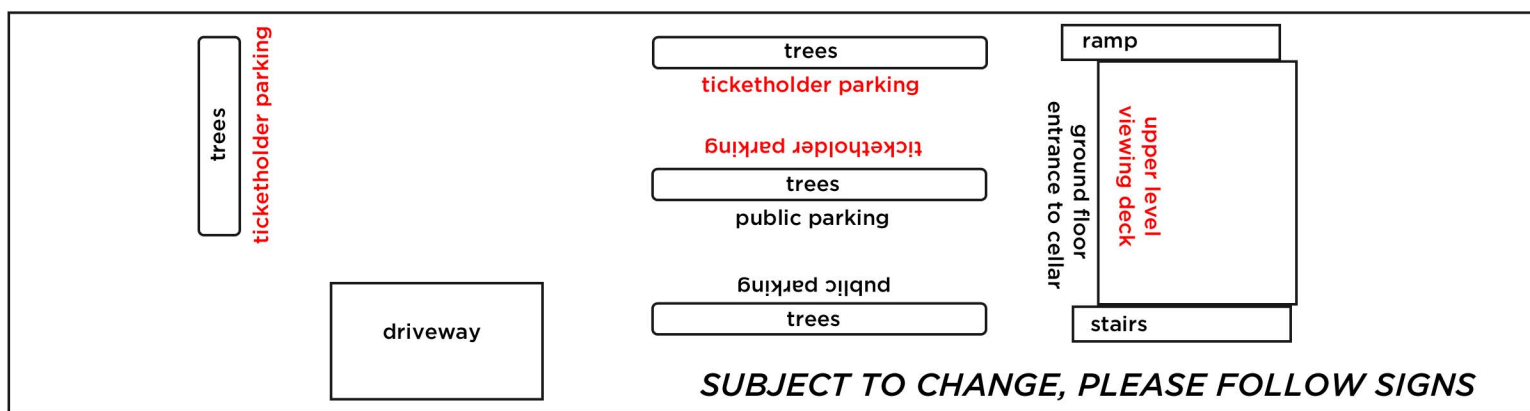


“LIGHTS OUT!” TICKETHOLDER INFORMATION HOST WINERY: SOUTH SHORE WINE COMPANY

WHAT TO BRING: Bring a chair, blanket, and dress for the weather! We suggest an umbrella, just in case. Feel free to bring cards or games to play!

PARKING INFO: Look for signs that indicate reserved parking for ticketholders (see map above)

VIEWING SPACE INFO: Ticketholders will have reserved viewing space on the upper deck accessible via ramp or stairs. There will be restrooms available up on the deck indoors. Additional indoor space will be open weather-dependent

ECLIPSE TIMING: First contact begins at 2:02 pm. Totality will be from 3:16 - 3:20 pm. Last contact will be at 4:30 pm. **The bar/register will be closed from 2:50 to 3:35** so our staff can also enjoy the Eclipse. Please be sure to grab drinks early!

OTHER INFO: *Please note, no tabs today, pay as you go. Large groups please pay together.*

DRINKS: Wine by the glass or bottle, eclipse-themed slushies and mimosas, and featured flights available for purchase in the cellar. No custom flights today. Water and juice are also available for purchase.

SNACKS: Eclipse-themed snacks will be available for CASH-ONLY at the reserved viewing area. Cheese/meats/crackers available for purchase in cellar.

MERCH: Exclusive limited edition Mazza Eclipse t-shirts, posters, and postcards are available for sale in cellar while supplies last!

ENTERTAINMENT: Jonathan Nolan will be providing some background music (with intermittent breaks) from about 1-5 pm w/ a break for the Eclipse. He'll be performing in the cellar or on the deck. Be sure to grab a selfie with the Eclipse frame and tag us at @mazzawines!
